



Production of Case Studies

A joint Case Study report for each of the following countries should be produced by the 2 project partners within that country - DE, FI, FR, UK. It must provide an overview of the specific example of their Trade Union - University collaboration in the provision of Work-based LLL opportunities to TU members.

The report of the Case Study should be minimum 6 sides in length. If you wish to use a media other than written text (e.g. video) for your report please contact the Co-ordinator. The report should be in **two** versions - in your own language and in English. The translation budget can be used for the associated translation work – contact the Co-ordinator for further information.

There is no need to repeat information contained within your National Report – you can cross-refer to the report, as appropriate.

The report should include:

- The philosophy behind the joint working
- Comments on the effectiveness of the activity, including identification of successes arising from the collaboration
- Identification of problems encountered in the collaboration, either externally generated or from within your own organisations
- Some comment on the political and social context of your TU-Uni collaboration (you can cross-refer to your national reports rather than duplicating the information if you prefer)
- Examples of different models of collaborative working arising from this activity
- Identification of transferability of experience /knowledge to other project partners
- Any websites or references for key documents, which are sources of further information relevant to your Case Study
