



## **Production of Descriptive Papers from the Learners' Perspective**

In conjunction with your Case Study, a Descriptive Paper *from the perspective of the Learner* (Trade Union member) for each of the following countries should be produced by the 2 project partners within that country - DE, FI, FR, UK. **BUT** the Learners do not have to write the Paper – this is to be done by the project partners.

It must illustrate specific LLL activities contained within your Case Study and report the views of the Learner on this activity. The 'voice' of the Learner on their experience./learning within the activity must be specifically included in the report (e.g. you may wish to use quotes etc).

The Descriptive Paper must be a separate document from the Case Study and be minimum 3-4 sides in length. If you wish to supplement it using other than written text (e.g. video) please contact the Co-ordinator. The Paper should be in **two** versions - in your own language and in English. The translation budget can be used for the associated translation work – contact the Co-ordinator for further information.

There is no need to repeat information contained within your Case Study – you can cross-refer as appropriate.

The Paper could include:

- Learners' comments on the effectiveness of the LLL activity, including identification of successes
- Learners' identification of problems encountered in the activity and your reflection on this and possible future actions as a result of this analysis
- Identification of transferability of experience /knowledge to other project partners
