

## **Romanian teachers are militating in favour of the grown-ups education**

The experts of the higher education, from the continuous education field of studies, met yesterday at an European conference lodged by the Faculty of Civil Engineering and Building Services of the "Gheorghe Asachi" Technical University of Iasi, in Romania. To this meeting are taking part university professors, as well as representatives of the specialized trade unions federations from countries like: Great Britain, France, Germany, Lithuania, Estonia, Slovenia and Romania, all names comprised by the TULIP program. "The main idea of the program is to develop the programs of continuous education, to create new opportunities to improve the grown-ups education through an amount of postgraduate- high school or college programs. For this edition we have tried to objectively analyze the existing partnership between the universities and the trade unions and we shall try to correct the deficiencies in order to correlate fast the autochthonous initiatives in this field with the European ones. We are obviously one or two years behind the other countries" explained Professor Gabriela Atanasiu.

There was broadly discussed the necessity to ease the educations paths proposed by the universities, about the importance of the trade unions during the process of introducing this system in the mentality of the countries newly accepted in the UE, or about the chance of the university institution to become a real fundamental, basic instrument of the continuous education.
